<u>Coggins Papers/Health Certificates</u>: In accordance with Virginia State Law, **ALL** horses and ponies on the grounds MUST have a current negative Coggins Certificate (within 12 months). *A copy of the certificate MUST be on file in the Show Office*. All Horses coming from out of state are required to have a 30 day Health Certificate. All non-showing horses on the grounds must be listed on an entry blank and present a Coggins as listed above. ANY HORSE NOT IN COMPLIANCE MUST VACATE PREMISES – NO EXCEPTIONS!

ENTRIES: All entries must be made on the entry blank provided or online at www.horseshowing.com. One horse per entry blank. If extra entry blanks are needed, photocopies are allowed. Entries will not be accepted over the phone or via text message. PRE ENTRIES AND PAYMENT MUST BE RECEIVED BY SEPTEMBER 17, 2025. LATE ENTRIES AND ADDS MUST LEAVE A FORM OF PAYMENT IN OFFICE BEFORE PICKING UP BACK NUMBER. THIS WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED!!!

Show Management reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally or cancel any entries of any exhibitor at its discretion and require horses and entrants to vacate the premises at its discretion.

NO STALLS will be reserved until payment for them is received. STALLS ARE LIMITED TACK STALLS are limited

PASSES - PRE-REGISTRATION/PAYMENT IS REQUIRED TO RECEIVE EXHIBITOR CREDENTIALS: Any exhibitors not pre-entered may be required to purchase a regular priced ticket each day. Every effort will be made to issue passes, if available. Exhibitor Passes will be mailed in advance to pre-entered. Each Exhibitor will get 2 passes and 1 parking pass. Pre-entered exhibitors requiring additional passes for workers may purchase a maximum of four (4) Exhibitor tickets for \$20.00, good for the duration of the show. These tickets must be purchased in advance on the entry form. Exhibitor credentials will provide admission to the Fair only; ride tickets must be purchased separately.

REFUNDS: Refunds requested prior to the entry closing date will be made in full, less a \$20 scratch fee, the non-refundable office fee and late penalty. No Refunds will be made after the closing date.

REGISTRATION PAPERS: A photocopy of registration papers FRONT AND BACK MUST accompany each horse entered A COPY MUST BE KEPT ON FILE IN THE SHOW OFFICE SO THESE COPIES WILL NOT BE RETURNED. Numbers will not be released for an entry without proper proof of registration. Registered Names of horses must be on the entry form. The word "entry" may not be used. All horses must be entered in their full registered name and number and in the current owner of record. No Part-Breds will be allowed at this show.

OFFICE HOURS: The Show Office will be open Tuesday 3PM - 7PM, Wednesday and Thursday 8AM to 30 minutes after the last class.

OPEN CHECKS/CREDIT CARD AUTHORIZATION FORMS: All accounts must leave an open check and/or credit card authorization form on file when picking up exhibitor packets - no exceptions. An Agent may fill in the check when showing is complete. If an exhibitor and/or agent fails to settle his/her account(s), the Show Secretary will fill in the correct amount on the open check and the exhibitor/agent relinquishes the right for adjustment after leaving the show.

RETURNED CHECKS: All checks returned for non-payment will be charged a \$50 handling fee and must be replaced by cash, certified check or cashier's check within 2 weeks of notification. All future fees will then be required to be paid with cash, money order or certified check.

IMPORTANT: ARRIVAL/DEPARTURE DAYS AND TIMES. There is no Early Arrival for this show. Move in will be Tuesday 9/30/2025 starting at 3pm. Move out by 10pm on 10/2/2025. Reminder that no stalls will be reserved until payment for them is received.

PARKING: Parking will NOT be permitted around the barn. Passenger vehicles should use the parking lot.

PHOTOGRAPHIC CONSENT: Anyone participating in any competition, event or demonstration at the State Fair of Virginia consents to the use of the Fair's photographic image of them or their exhibit, by the State Fair of Virginia, agents, licensees, and assigns for any and all purposes, including without limitation television, theater, exhibition, website, publication and any trade or advertising purposes. Competitor/exhibitor understands there will be no remuneration for the use of such image.

<u>CAMPERS</u>: A limited number of RV spaces are available but must use a generator. No advance reservations will be taken. RV space rentals are \$30 per night and will be taken on a first-come, first-serve basis. NO trailers, campers, RVs, etc will be allowed to plug into barn, stable or ring hook-ups.

DAMAGE: The Meadow Park Event Center holds individual owners and exhibitors responsible for damages incurred by them, or their agents, to barns or other properties on the show grounds and will invoice them accordingly. J & S Equestrian Events, LLC and/or Show Management will in no way be responsible for any loss/damage that may occur. It will be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the competition, its management and The Meadow Park Event Center blameless for any loss or accident to his/her horse(s) or equipment that may occur from sickness, fire or otherwise. The VA Gypsy Vanner Horse Show, show management or The Meadow Park Event Center will not be responsible or liable for injuries sustained in any way to exhibitors, spectators, employees or other interested parties.

Only authorized persons shall be allowed in the ring during judging. Any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the judges or officials on the part of an owner, rider/driver, trainer/agent or groom will disqualify horse or rider/driver and the owner shall forfeit his/her entry and other fees, including prize money won.

<u>SHAVINGS/BEDDING</u>: Shavings will be available on the grounds for \$9.50/bale (10 cubic feet compressed). Sales will be available from 8:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m. daily. *ALL STALLS MUST USE BEDDING*– *YOU MAY BRING YOUR OWN*.

<u>CHANGES/CANCELLATIONS</u>: Management reserves the right to combine or cancel any class having less than two (2) entries. Management also reserves the right to change or alter the officials listed without notice prior to or during the show.

CLASS CALLS/GATE HOLDS: Every effort will be made to maintain a working PA system. HOWEVER, due to unforeseen problems with any mechanical device, the PA system and paddock calls must be considered a courtesy. IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE EXHIBITOR to be sure that his/her horse is at the gate at the designated time. A two (2) minute gate rule will be strictly enforced. The gate will be closed two (2) minutes after the first horse enters the ring.

SPORTSMANSHIP: Any unsportsmanlike conduct by an exhibitor will disqualify both exhibitor and horse from the show.

GROOMING, CONDITION, ATTIRE: Animals must be in show condition; exhibitors, handlers, and teamsters must be dressed in neat, clean clothes appropriate to their class. Prizes may not be awarded to animals that are not in show condition and/or properly groomed.

INTERFERENCE WITH JUDGE: The judge shall report to the management any exhibitor or exhibitors who in any way, whether in person or by agents or employees, interfere with him during his adjudication or manifest any disrespect to him, whereupon a proper apology from such exhibitor shall be demanded. Any exhibitor who refuses to comply with this rule may be excluded from further competition and management may withhold any premiums that may have been awarded to him.

LIABILITY: Upon submission of entry blank, exhibitor releases and waives all rights against J & S Equestrian Events, LLC. and its officers, directors, employees, agents or representatives, the State Fair of Virginia (Commonwealth Fairs & Events) and its officers, directors, employees, agents or representatives, and the management of this show and pull, for death, personal injury or property damage and waives the right to sue or to bring action against J & S Equestrian Events, LLC. or the State Fair of Virginia (Commonwealth Fairs & Events) for any loss or damage which is in any way connected with the risks involved in equine activity.

MISTREATMENT: Any exhibitor or other person, directing physical abuse in any form towards a horse, will be immediately dismissed from the show and will forfeit all fees
