

Florida All Breed Horse Show Series Divisions 2026

At least three exhibitors must enter a division for daily titles to be awarded.

Speed must show in four eligible classes to qualify for daily Champion and Reserve titles.

-Leadline may not cross enter into any other class other than Walk at the same show.

Leadline Western must show at least two classes and English must show at least three classes for daily Champion and Reserve Titles.

FLORIDA ALL BREED DIVISION AND YEAR END AWARDS RULES

2026 Show season is January 30 through December 13th. We have eight shows for the 2026 season.
We do NOT require any type of membership fee or sign up for your points to count.

Qualification for year end circuit awards requires exhibitors to show in a minimum of FIVE shows. To be eligible to win a year end circuit division award you must show in your qualifying division at least FOUR times.

Double pointed Shows March, May, and September
Double pointed shows allow exhibitors to receive double points in classes.
Double pointed shows count as ONE show for participation requirements.

Points will be awarded as follows:

- First Place - 10 Points
- Second Place - 6 Points
- Third Place - 4 Points
- Fourth Place - 2 Points
- Fifth Place - 1 Point
- Sixth Place - 1/2 Point
- Champion - 20 points
- Reserve - 12 points

- Points are awarded and tracked by the exhibitor. An exhibitor may show multiple horses in a show and for the year.
- Ribbons or choice of prize awarded 1st - 6th in all classes except warm up rounds.
- Champion and Reserve ribbons awarded in all listed divisions every show if requirements are met. Minimum of three entries entered in division and listed minimum number of qualifying classes entered by the exhibitor to be awarded.
- Points for year end circuit divisions will be earned by exhibitors even if daily title awards are not awarded.
- Daily Champion and Reserve awards will be awarded to the horse/exhibitor combination that meets listed requirements over an exhibitor who exhibits multiple horses to meet qualifications.
- Should an exhibitor, parent or trainer forfeit a title award to the show office, the next eligible exhibitors will receive Champion and Reserve titles for the show. Points for the circuit will reflect original standings prior to forfeit.
- For exhibitors showing multiple horses in the same divisions that allow multiple entries, year end circuit points will be earned. This includes all eligible classes that exhibitors can show as many horses as they enter at each show. Exhibitors can earn respective Champion and Reserve titles with multiple horses during the show in the same division.
- 2026 Championship classes will be offered in December at the Championship show to those placing 1st - 6th in class type/event anytime during the show season.
- There will be no restrictions on the amount of divisions, heights or titles won for high points or year end as long as the horse's welfare is prioritized. Management has the right at their discretion to scratch or send the horse home for any reason with no refund.
- Management has the right to cancel and remove any division without participation. Should management remove a division with participation for any reason your points may be moved to another division or a combined similar division at management's discretion.

Divisions must have three qualifying exhibitors to be awarded year end unless the division is sponsored. Any sponsored division will automatically be awarded at the end of the year.

We do allow cross entry across all divisions however exhibitors must follow any restrictions listed on the division sheet. Exhibitors must declare divisions they would like to be eligible for daily titles as Champion or Reserve before they start showing at each show in the office. The division declared by the exhibitor for daily titles, is the division year end points will be calculated for circuit standings at that show.
